Human Rights Protection Intervention

Capacity Building

Undertake capacity building activities to the relevant authorities with aim to expand their knowledge and skills in protecting people UNHCR cares for.

Child Protection

Focus on child protection and access to their rights, i.e. registration, education, health, sports.

Undertake assessments

on different legal issues and provide commentaries to authorities on identified protection gaps that need resolution.



Legal Aid and Assistance



with Roma, Ashkali and Egyptian communities to identify protection gaps, prioritize community needs that local and central authorities can address.



Court Representations



on legal remedies and complaint mechanisms targeting vulnerable communities' groups.
